How to Apply:

Requirements:

- A safety-conscious attitude
- Team player
- Physical strength and stamina
- Manual dexterity
- Ability to use stairs, ladders, and climb over rough terrain
- Ability to work long hours per day sometimes in rough weather conditions
- Must hold a valid driver's license (G Class)
- Must possess High School diploma, GED or equivalent

- Must be eligible to work in Canada
- Construction experience is an asset – **but NOT required for Labourer positions**

What happens after I apply?

After you apply your application will be reviewed by Aecon's Talent Acquisition team. A pre-screen interview will be conducted with you if selected. If you are selected for the next round, you will be invited for an in-person interview with an Operations Manager. When the final round of interviews is completed, those who are selected will be onboarded on-site for further training.

Will I be trained?

Yes, you will be trained. We provide training on-site to get you started in your new role. After that, training is provided by the respective union you will join.

Is training paid?

Although training in our industry is typically unpaid, Aecon will be paying minimum wage for all the hours of training you complete.

Where does training take place?

Training is conducted within the Six Nations communities. Specifically, in **Oshweken, Ontario**. There will also be training at the respective union that you join.
